

Mutton Hollow Road Reconstruction & Utilities Project

Starting Wednesday, May 11th Kaysville City will begin construction on Mutton Hollow to replace the waterline and rebuild Mutton Hollow Road. Crews will begin setting up traffic control and staging equipment May 9th and 10th.

Anticipated project end date is Mid-August. **Mutton Hollow will be open to local traffic and school buses**.

► PROJECT AREA



Project area will extend from Fairfield Rd. to Main St. Crews will begin by milling the road the entire length of the project and then start utility work on the east side near Fairfield Rd.

North Davis Sewer District (NDSD) will be working on the west side of Mutton Hollow near Main St. starting Monday, May 16th to replacement a sewer line separate from this project.

► SAFETY

Safety is a top priority for Kaysville City. We encourage and appreciate neighborhood participation to keep children away from the construction equipment and work areas. Parents, please talk with your children about staying away from potentially dangerous construction and watching for construction vehicles.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS AND PLAN OF ACTION

While Kaysville City aims to keep construction impacts as minimal as possible, some impacts are unavoidable. Residents and drivers in the area can expect:

Construction Impacts	Planned Actions to Reduce Impacts
Noise, dust, and vibrations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» Work hours: 7 am to 7 pm (Active construction during daylight hours)» Some noise and dust
Traffic impacts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» Closed to through traffic» Signage/Detours» Fliers/Notices of upcoming impacts
Driveway access	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» Coordination with properties impacted ahead of the work
Project construction	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» Coordination and communication with Kaysville City, individual residents and homeowners, commuters,» Project dedicated community liaison to hear and resolve any issues or complaints
Water Service Interruptions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» Minimize shut down times» Resident coordination - 24 hr. minimum notice
